Report at March 2024 Regular Meeting

From Executive Board Report: Upgrade Pumpstation Sunrise Acres Akwesasne-Perras, Navy federal Credit Union Evans Mills-Blackstone, Beaver River COP-GC Dow (NU) \$44,500 Electric self-perform, COP Thousand Islands CSD-Empire Northeast (NU) \$944,450, COP South Jefferson CSD-S&L \$1,200,000.

Upcoming work includes: Inflight Interceptor Communication Systems Fort Drum, ST Regis Mohawk Tribe New Wastewater Treatment Plant, Beaver Falls WWTF, SUNY Potsdam Timmerman Lab, COP Thousand Island CSD Phase 2, Long Sault Dam Gate Hoist Automation, Massena Green Energy Hydrogen Plant Buildings, Tupper Lake 99 Park St. Renovations, Clifton Fine Hospital Renovations, SUNY Potsdam Raymond Hall, Potsdam CSD Replace Ceilings, Town of Diana Water System Improvements, Massena International Airport Salt Storage Building, Thompson Park Bandstand Watertown, Homeward Bound ADK Building, Tug Hill Roasters Building Renovations, Watertown CSD Capital Improvement Project Phase 2 and NYPA Crane Replacements.

The bid activity is starting to pick back up, which is always a good sign and there have been job calls coming in over the last couple of weeks. Michels Power has been hiring and expects to continue building up their crew size on multiple sites. Schuler Haas has 4 solar projects in our jurisdiction, one has started, and the rest are scheduled to start before June.

Work has resumed at the Massena Green Energy Hydrogen Facility, but progress is being slowed by the mud. They are hoping to get two buildings up by November so they can work through the Winter. Let's hope for some dry weather, it will help several of these projects continue to move forward.

Our wage increase was voted on at the regular meeting in March, we decided to put \$1.50 in wages, \$.50 Pension, \$.50 Health and Welfare and \$.50 in the annuity. These increases will go into effect April 1, 2024.
