Report at July 2023 Regular Meeting

U=Union / NU = Non Union

Currently we have 51 Journeymen on Book I, 7 on Book II, 10 Apprentices available, 8 Residential - CE / CW's and 0 Teledata Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Transitional Living Services WTN-Parking Lot Upgrades Powis (NU), Lake Clear Transfer Station Improvements Dow (NU) \$105,950, Lift Stations Generator-Watertown Northern Pioneer \$175,680, Chazy School-Business Lab ACE (NU) \$24,120, and Ogdensburg CSD Watson \$22,503.

From Executive Board Report: St. Lawrence Appleton Arena-S&L, Adirondack CF Building 1 & 20 Roof Replacement-Weydman \$88,000, Town of Chazy Sewer pump station upgrades-Weydman, Parishville Hopkinton CSD COP-Zero Draft Commercial (NU), Replacement of windows and lights for Flower Memorial Library- Zero Draft Commercial (NU), SUNY Canton-CARC Replace VESDA Fire Alarm System-TEL Inc. \$57,097, and Eisenhower & Snell Lock Compressor Building Feeders-Collins-Hammond \$675,243.

Upcoming work includes: Keeseville Waterfront Park, Sackets Harbor CSD-Pavilion, Fort Drum MQ-9 Shops, Fort Drum In-Flight Interceptor-Com System, SOIRA Generator Install-Potsdam, SOIRA Generator Install-Massena, Farm Worker Housing- Essex County, Plattsburgh State University-Memorial Hall, Dollar General-West Carthage, Upstate Correctional Facility-Elevator Repairs, and Dulles State Office Building-Elevator Replacement.

The solar project O'Connell has been working on is nearly complete. They laid off most of their crew last week. The timing was good as almost everyone was able to get right back out on other calls.

I met with representatives of The Bridge and Port Authority to talk about upcoming work at the Ogdensburg Airport. They said there is funding for substantial construction projects at both the Watertown and Ogdensburg Airports. They also have plans for a 15,000 square foot Childcare Facility that will be built on Bridge and Port Authority Property. I am hoping we can get a PLA for the Ogdensburg Project; it's not very likely for the Watertown project. The PLA for the Massena Hydrogen Plant has still not been finalized. Most of our work will be in the spring of 2024.

I am attending a meeting with the Workforce Development Board to discuss ways to recruit a workforce to keep up with demand during this labor shortage.
