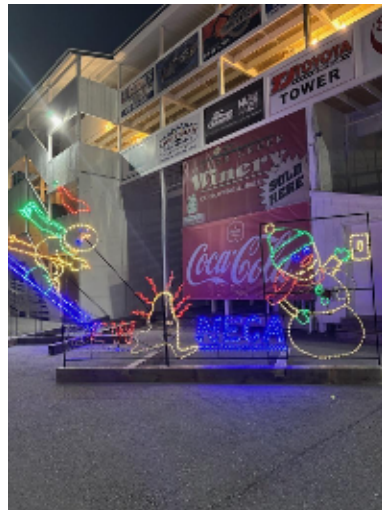

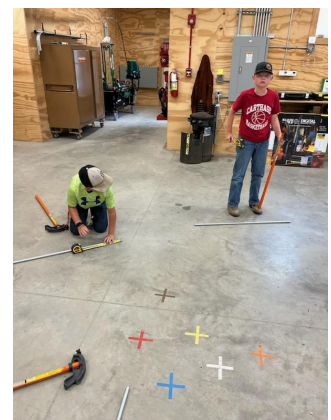


IBEW Display that is used

Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 45 Journeymen on Book I, 3 on Book II, 2 Apprentices, 28 CE/CW's and 3 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: City of Plattsburgh Water Improvements Phase2 -Weydman \$577,000; SUNY Plattsburgh Harrington Hall Lounge-GC-Dow Electric (NU) \$243,000; NYS Route 56 Water District Town of Potsdam-Khars Construction (NU) \$304,000; Constableville Wastewater Treatment Plant UV Disinfection-Blackstone \$96,727; SUNY Potsdam Camera Initiative- S&L \$285,000; CVES BOCES Weydman & Carey Electric \$4.8 M. and Champlain Warehouse Weydman (No Price).

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include (From Executive Meeting): SUNY Plattsburgh Hudson Annex Replace 3 Rooftop Fan Units-Weydman, Indian River CS Capital Project-Next Era (NU) \$774,000, Plattsburgh Warehouse-Weydman no price and Canton BOCES Mechanical & Electrical Upgrades-Collins-Hammond \$102,000.

Upcoming work includes: Edwards Knox CSD Capital Outlay, Pierrepont Highway Department Building, SUNY Potsdam Flagg Advising, Ogdensburg Housing Authority Boiler Replacement, Whetstone Gulf Bathroom Replacement, Wanakena Ranger School Boiler Replacement, Gouverneur CSD Phase 2, City of Ogdensburg Generator Replacement Main Street Pumpstation, Town of Clayton Electric Charging Stations, Whetstone Gulf Restrooms, LaFargeville CSD Phase 2, Wanakena Ranger School Water Heater, Hopkinton New Fire Station, Gouverneur CSD Phase 2, Warneck Pumpstation FEMA Repairs, ACAP renovation Ausable, Ogdensburg Pump Station Generator, Trout River LPOE Facility Expansion.

I met with NYPA to discuss the development of a zero admission Advanced Nuclear Power plant. They are in the very early stages of development. Nothing has been decided as for a location, but they are not going to build it in a community that doesn't want it.

The Cider Creek Solar Project in the Rochester/Buffalo area has broken ground. The developer is going forward with the project using Union Carpenters to complete all aspects of the project. IBEW Local 41 and 86 will be picketing soon. If anyone is interested in offering their support, please let me know.

We have had a few job calls lately, but other jobs have laid off, so the book has basically stayed the same. Local 86, 237 and 41 are all reporting open calls. Local 43 is expecting their books to clear in mid-July with calls expected at Turning Stone.
