Report at November 2022 Regular Meeting

U=Union / NU = Non Union

Currently we have 45 Journeymen on Book I, 7 on Book II, 0 Apprentices available, 2 Residential, CE, CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: There is nothing to report at this time.

From Executive Board report:

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Village of Waddington – Construction of Public Dockage went to Tel, Inc.(U) for \$376,310, Salmon River CSD – Bus Garage & Fuel Tank Reconstruction went to S&L(U) for \$69,000, Salmon River CSD – Capital Project Phase 5 went to S&L for \$66,000, and Watertown City Schools- 2021 Capital Improvement Project went to S&L for \$760,000,

Upcoming work includes: Water Supply Improvements – Au Sable Forks, Brasher Falls School – Capital Outlay, St. Lawrence Seaway – Power Upgrades, Renovate Memorial Hall, SUNY Plattsburg, Emergency Department (Addition/Renovations) Clifton-Fine Hospital, Au Sable Forks Fire District New Fire Station, SUNY Potsdam - Carson Hall Renovation, Watertown City Schools, Canton School, and several more smaller projects for ORDA. Additionally, there are several large solar projects.

School projects that are in various stages of development: Parishville-Hopkinton \$2.3 million, Brushton-Moira \$11.5 million, Indian River \$41 million, Carthage \$35 million, Madrid Waddington \$5 million, and Potsdam \$23.5 million.

The out-of-work list remains stable with a few getting laid off and a few others taking calls. The only call we have currently is a short call for S&L at the Tupper Lake Hardwood for 1 Journeyman. Mass Electric let us know that the Farney Solar project has just started. They were not expecting it to go until spring. Mass reports that they will be placing calls of 3 to 5 Journeymen this week and plan to max out at 15-20 within the next 2-3 weeks. The deal will be the same as the Zehr site, (5) x 9 hour days with an \$80 per diem.

The outside the area electrical contractor who had the Love's Truckstop on outer Bradley Street has backed out of the job. Several of our contractors have been contacted. There are also two (2) fast food restaurants within the truck stop that are being bid separately.

Last week I attended Trustee Training through the International Foundation for Employee Benefit Plans. From the sessions that I attended, we are in good shape with the latest concerns for Local Unions, Benefit Funds and Apprenticeships programs. Cyber Security and the Economy were the hot topics. We are on pace to have all 3 entities ahead of curve on Cyber Security. The Speakers who addressed the current economic situation believe the market will be mostly negative for the next 6 months; then be on the road to recovery barring any catastrophe around the world.

A moment of silence was held for deceased Brother William Jette.

TWO ITEMS OF NOTE:

1. Dues are increasing to \$138.60 per quarter for Journeyman and \$132.60 per quarter for Apprentice.
