Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 48 Journeymen on Book I, 0 on Book II, 2 Apprentices, 10 CE/CW's and 2 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Plattsburgh Airport Security Access Control Rebid-S&L \$1,646,843, Ticonderoga Police Department Rehab-GC Gallo \$339,500 Electric-Hour Electric (no price), North Country Family Health Center Lowville-Northern Pioneer (no price), SUNY Plattsburgh HVAC Units-LH Laplante \$595,000 Electric Weydman (no price), Solar Array Westport-Albany Solar Solutions (NU) \$100,000, Moriah Shock Incarceration Facility Closure-Tadcon (NU) 10%, Upstate Correctional Facility Cold Storage Building-Next Era (NU) \$306,900, Ogdensburg Correctional Facility Closure-Tadcon (NU) 14%, Carthage WWTP-Blackstone \$76,500, Lisbon CSD Rebid-S&L (no price), Morristown CSD Capital Project Phase 2-TEL Inc.(no price), EV Charging Stations Ramada Inn Watertown-Twin Electrical (no price).

Upcoming work includes: Alexandria Bay Water System Improvements, Sunmount DDSO Loading Docks, General Brown CSD Phase 2, St. Lawrence Psych Center Decentralize Steam, Wheeler Sack Army Airfield Lighting Project.

Upcoming work includes from E-Board: Capital Project Potsdam CSD, Renovations of Watertown City Court, ORDA Medium Voltage Electric IQC, Capital Project Beaver River CSD.

Work continues to be busy in Clinton and Essex Counties, we have unfilled calls in Plattsburgh, Lake Placid and Ticonderoga. We have added a few electricians, but we still need more. We are trying to get in touch with more Ace Electric employees so if anyone knows somebody working for Ace, please let us know.

The Wheeler Sack Airfield Lighting Project will be done under a PLA. We are working on getting union bidders for this project.

We are starting negotiations with the Champlain Telephone Company this month. I have a few dates blocked out this week and next. Our negotiating committee is made up of a good group of people so I am optimistic that we will get a good contract.

I will be attending a Labor Luncheon with Governor Hochul later this month. Locally we will be focusing on the reform of section 224, which calls for Prevailing wage on privately funded projects under certain circumstances.
