Report at January 2023 Regular Meeting

U=Union / NU = Non Union

Currently we have 67 Journeymen on Book I, 8 on Book II, 2 Apprentices available, 0 Residential, CE, CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Potsdam CSD – 2021 Capital Improvement Project-Dow (NU) for \$772,200 and Harrisville CSD- Capital Outlay Project- Empire Northeast (NU) no price.

Upcoming work includes: Chateaugay CSD, North Country Children Museum Potsdam, Transitional Living Services Watertown, Town Of Keene Library Renovation, Ogdensburg Main Street Pumpstation, Tupper Lake Middle School Elevator Modernization, Edwards Knox Capital Outlay and Rehab Parking Garage in Watertown.

School projects that are in various stages of development: Parishville-Hopkinton \$2.3 million, Brushton-Moira \$11.5 million, Indian River \$41 million, Carthage \$35 million, Madrid Waddington \$5 million and Potsdam \$23.5 million.

There is a new Land Port of Entry facility being proposed in Rouses Point. The project would add new inspection lanes and a rail inspection platform. The Trout River Land Port of Entry in Constable also has a project proposed. It would include a 14,405 square ft. building, two inspection booths and a new canopy. At this point they are in the planning phase only. The project is estimated to take 18 months and be between \$25 and \$30 million dollars. The notice to proceed is expected in December of 2023.

I have been working on negotiations for Northern Credit Union, Officer elections for Champlain Telephone Company and our inside negotiations.
