Report at January 2024 Regular Meeting

Currently we have 56 Journeymen on Book I, 0 on Book II, 17 Apprentices, 9 Residential-CE/CW's and 1 Tele-data Technician available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Westport Sewer Improvements-Weydman \$42,500; and Canton BOCES-Conference Center Empire Northeast.

From Executive Board Report: Lowville Walmart-Mcgowan PLD (U), Northeastern Clinton CSD Phase 3 Rebid-Next Era (NU) \$253,450, Canton BOCES Conf. Room-Empire (NU), New Highway Administration Building Jefferson County-Northern Pioneer \$139,000, Lowville Academy Central School-Northern Pioneer \$1,374,500, Suny Plattsburgh Parking Lots and Roadways-Triangle.

Upcoming work includes: General Brown CSD Bus Garage-REBID, St. Lawrence Psych Center Chiller Replacement REBID, Canton Public Safety Complex-Renovations, SUNY Potsdam Fire Alarm, Sackets Harbor Pump Station, Edwards Knox CSD Central Building Bus Garage and Field House, SUNY Plattsburgh Chiller Replacement, Ogdensburg PLA Project, and New Champlain Fire Station, St. Regis Mohawk Tribe Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The work situation continues to be slow. There isn't much out to bid right now either. We are hoping for an early spring so some of the larger solar projects can start. Local 86 Rochester and Local 43 Syracuse continue to be good places to sign if you are interested in working outside of our Local. There are also several open calls throughout the United States. If you are looking to travel for work, call the office and we can help you with the process.

Dave, Justin, and I met with our Business Development Representative Ed Hill Jr. to stay current tracking all of the solar projects in our area. We are also looking into connecting developers in the area with some of the Investment firms Ed has contacts with. We have a meeting scheduled with the Thousand Islands Local Development Corporation regarding the proposed Thousand Islands Event Center.

I have met with a couple of our members who are interested in starting their own contracting business and two of them have decided to go forward with it. It will be nice to have a few more contractors doing residential work.
