Report at December 2021 Regular Meeting

Currently we have 48 Journeymen on Book I, 7 on Book II, 0 Apprentices available, 0 Residential, CE, CW's and 1 Tele-data Technician available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Plattsburg Airport Fuel Farm Modifications went to WJ Murray (U) for \$15,500 and Newcomb CSD Capital Renovations Phase 1 rebid went to Watson (U) for \$155,724.

From Executive Board Report;

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Crown Point - Water Source Improvements had Hour Electric (U) low at \$125,000; South Lewis Capital Outlay went to Northern Pioneer (U) for \$13,450; and Chateaugay CSD - Capital Improvements Project went to Watson Electric (U) for \$113,017.

Upcoming work includes: NYPA – Saranac Digital Substation in Caddyville, Massena Substation Breaker Replacement, Lewis County General Hospital Addition and Revitalization, STL Water Tower Replacement Massena NYPA, Center CJ Intelligence & Cyber Security Renovation, Dana Hall- SUNY Canton, NYPA MA-Advance Power Flow Control Project, Water Supply Improvements – Au Sable Forks, Brasher Falls School – Capital Outlay, St. Lawrence Seaway – Power Upgrades, Renovate Memorial Hall, SUNY Plattsburg, Newcomb CSD Capital Renovations and Harrisville - Bus Garage Reconstruction. There are several large solar projects in the works.

School projects that are in various stages of development: Parishville-Hopkinton \$2.3 million, Brushton-Moira \$11.5 million, Indian River \$41 million, Carthage \$35 million, Madrid Waddington \$5 million and Potsdam \$23.5 million.

Currently we have 9 calls on the job line, totaling 16 Journeymen needed for regular calls. The jobs are in Massena, Plattsburgh, Chaumont, Lowville and the Olympic venues in and around Lake Placid. The Chaumont call is 6x10's and has been running for over a week and still not getting any response. Mass Electric put a call in for 6 Journeymen yesterday. Two Local 236 members who had been working for them in Local 43 signed Book II and were the only members to respond. That job is working 5-9's and paying \$80 per day per diem.

Several of the projects our contractors are working on have been greatly affected by the uptick in Covid infections across the jurisdiction in the last few months. Members testing positive, or being under an order of quarantine as a result of exposure to someone that tested positive, has resulted in jobs left extremely short of manpower. We are all aware of the calls going unfilled this year so simply hiring to make up the difference is not an option. The result is several jobs falling behind, or needing the crew to work overtime.

I realize it is each person's decision on whether to get the vaccine or not. I respect everyone's own opinion and choices. However, I want to make it clear that I encourage all of our members to get the Covid vaccine unless they have a medical condition that could cause complications. If anyone wants to discuss this further, I am more than willing to speak with you individually on why I feel this way.

The dues pay and the job calls are now live on our web site.
