Report at December 2023 Regular Meeting

Currently we have 58 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 17 Apprentices, 4 Residential-CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Canton Willow Island Park Improvements-Watson and St. Lawrence County Public Safety Complex-S&L 572,000.

From Executive Board Report: Dicks Sporting Goods-Pompo (NU), Fort Drum MQ9 Shops-NYTRIC, Gouverneur Correctional Facility Rec Pens-Dow Electric (NU) \$1,155,249, Town of Lyme New Highway Garage-New Century Electric \$313,932 and St. Lawrence Suds-Collins-Hammond \$132,000.

Upcoming work includes: Lowville WalMart Renovation, Potsdam WalMart Renovation, Brasher Falls CSD Capital Outlay, SUNY Potsdam Replace Roof Schuette Hall, Watertown Airport Temporary Terminal, Northeastern Clinton CSD Phase 3 Rebid (Watson had first bid \$481,523), Norsk Titanium HVAC Upgrades, Westport Sewer Improvements, Malone CSD Phase 2, Canton BOCES Conference Room Improvements, Lowville Academy Central School Capital Improvements, SUNY Potsdam Fire Alarm, Westport Sewer Improvements, Malone Secore Building Renovations, Canton BOCES Conference Room Renovation, Jefferson County Highway Administration New Building, Lowville Academy Capital Improvement Project and SUNY Plattsburgh Parking Lots.

We negotiated a new contract with The Champlain Telephone Company and the members voted unanimously to approve.

Justin, Dave, and I met with our International Representatives to discuss the new IBEW Organizing Policy. We mostly discussed our current plans and policies and what we have to do to be compliant with the new policy.

Governor Kathy Hochul today announced that BETA Technologies will partner with Clinton County on a \$41 million expansion of its existing facility at Plattsburgh International Airport. The new, upgraded facility will serve as the manufacturing and final assembly hub for BETA's all-electric aircraft and will establish a permanent flight test and aircraft delivery center, responsible for final flight testing, aircraft painting, and customer delivery, at one of the North Country's busiest transit hubs. As part of the agreement to expand operations at Plattsburgh International Airport, BETA Technologies has committed to creating 85 full time jobs in exchange for a \$20 million grant awarded to BETA via Clinton County from Empire State Development's Regional Economic and Community Assistance Program.

We have a Project Labor Agreement finalized for the \$21.5 Million Ogdensburg International Airport Modernization Project. This project includes an expanded Terminal Lobby, Multipurpose Great Room, New Entrance Canopy, Solar Panels, Electric Vehicle Charging Stations, and Security Upgrades. The project is scheduled to be completed by the spring of 2025.
