Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Northeast Clinton CSD-Watson \$481,523, TI Park WWTP Upgrades-Watson \$54,963; Copenhagen WWTP-SC Spencer (NU) \$69,300; Watertown City Pool- Blackstone \$361,935; Lewis County Public Safety Building Parking Lot Improvements-Spencer (NU) no price; and Franklin County Highway Garage- Weydman \$144,000.

From Executive Board Report: Burger King Renovations Fort Drum-NYTRIC; SUNY Canton Parking Lot Upgrades-TEL Inc; TI Bridge Authority Fueling Station-Bach and Co. (NU); JCC Maintenance Contract-New Century Electric; and Plattsburgh WWTP-Triangle \$1,638,600.

Upcoming work includes: City of Plattsburgh-WTP Upgrades, EMS building Village of Dannemora, Upgrades to fire stations 1,2, & 3 City of Watertown, IFB pump rehabilitation for DANC Watertown, Improvements to Parking Lot Transitional Living Services NNY Watertown, and Dollar General Henderson.

Community Health Center Renovation-Canton, ADK Correctional Facility Roof Replacement-Raybrook, Water Treatment Upgrades-Denmark, Dollar General-Martinsburg, Lake Clear Transfer Station, Watertown Lift Stations Generator, Parishville-Hopkinton CSD COP Project, South Lewis CSD COP Project, Town of Chazy Pump Stations, Chazy School-Business Lab Reconstruction, SLC Arts Renovation-Potsdam, Ogdensburg CSD-Capital Outlay Project, Generator Replacement-Akwesasne Housing Authority, Lighting Replacement Flower Memorial Library-Watertown, and SUNY Canton Replace VESDA Fire Alarm System.

I talked to a Superintendent working for Michels Power on the NYPA Sub Station projects. He said they are behind schedule due to not having approved drawings and not expected to be hiring inside Electricians until August.

The Austin Road Substation that O'Connell Electric is doing is also expected to start hiring in the Fall.

We are close to finalizing a Project Labor Agreement with Air Products for the Massena Hydrogen Plant. Most of our work will be in the spring of 2024.

We are working with WWNY-TV on marketing, which will include television ads, online advertising, and sponsorship of the Emily Griffin segment on the AM news. Once we have this completed, we will be looking into similar opportunities with NBC 5 Burlington/Plattsburgh.

Friday July 28 will be our IBEW night at the Watertown Rapids Game.
