Report at May 2023 Regular Meeting

Currently we have 47 Journeymen on Book I, 7 on Book II, 4 Apprentices available, 1 Residential-CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Watertown Dept of Water-Charging Station Watson Electric \$56,717; Carthage CSD Phase 4 Watson Electric \$330,615 and Thompson Park Golf Club Upgrades Blackstone Electric \$54,126.

From Executive Board Report:

Massena Airport Improvements Baseline \$784,000 (NU); Sackets Harbor Market Square Park Lawman Heating & Cooling 1.2 million; and North Country Community College Lab Renovation Rozell East (U) No price.

Upcoming work includes: Crown Point Wastewater Treatment Plant, St. Lawrence University Appleton Arena Phase 2, and Town Of Orleans WWTF Upgrades.

Our updated Drug and Alcohol Policy has been reviewed by our Attorney and minor changes have been recommended. We will finalize the policy and resume testing soon.
