Business Manager's Report

Currently we have 63 Journeymen on Book I, 3 on Book II, 13 Apprentices, 40 CE/CW's and 3 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

(no price), Wellesley Island State Park Office-Blackstone \$284,910, Heuvelton CSD Capital Improvements-Collins-Hammond \$1,000,000, Mt. Van Hoevenberg Sliding Track Lighting System-Gross Electric \$3,587,569, National Grid Substations Beaver Falls and Watertown-Michels (no price).

From Executive Board Report: Tupper Lake CSD-Watson \$791,500, Malone Ground Water Control Building-Weydman \$331,000, Hammond CSD Phase 2-Collins-Hammond \$355,000, Beaver River CSD-Empire Northeast (NU) \$85,899.

Upcoming work includes: Sackets Harbor CSD, Plattsburgh Airport De-icing System, Capital Improvements Phase 1 MS Athletic Facility Gouverneur, Battlefield Memorial Gateway Phase 2 Plattsburgh, Potsdam Municipal Airport Beacon & Tower Replace, City of Plattsburgh Drinking Water Improvements Phase 2, SUNY Plattsburgh HVAC Improvements, Gouverneur CSD Athletic Facility, Plattsburgh Battlefield Memorial Gateway, SUNY Potsdam Wiser Botanical Gardens, Whiteface Silo Electrical Upgrades Phase 2, City of Plattsburgh Water Improvements Phase 2, Village of Potsdam Riverwalk and Streetscape, Village of Dexter STP Disinfection Improvements, Watertown Airport Runway 1028 Phase 2, SUNY Plattsburgh Harrington Hall Lounge Improvements, NYS 56 Water District Potsdam, Constableville WTP Disinfection, River Hospital Renovations.

We had a meeting with Jeff Ferrell from NYPA, and NYS North Country Regional Representative Sean Hennessey about a proposed Data Center in Massena. Jeff said that NYPA has received calls from Schumer's, Stefanik's, and Gray's offices about the project. They still can't reach an agreement on the cost of a new substation.

I regrouped with the investment group for this project and it seems to me they have lost interest in the project.

National Grid Substations in Beaver Falls and Watertown have been awarded to Michels. Justin and I met with Superintendents from Michels about the timeline for these projects and the other projects they are working on currently. Coffeen Street is supposed to start in mid-June, Beaver Falls 2026 and ADK Sub will be ramping up this month.

I met with two of Chuck Schumer's office staff last week. We talked about the Kraft Project and some of the infrastructure projects that are at risk due to the new administration.

I also met with DANC about a new initiative called Next Move NY.
