Report at February 2023 Regular Meeting

U=Union / NU = Non Union

Currently we have 69 Journeymen on Book I, 8 on Book II, 2 Apprentices available, 1 Residential, CE, CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: North Country Children's Museum Potsdam, GC-Northern Tier Contracting; Rt 12 Sewer District 2, Kahrs (NU) \$428,000 (only bidder); Rehab Parking Garage Watertown, KS Construction \$2,080,000; former Clinton County Airport, ACE (NU) \$513,600; Ogdensburg Housing Authority Upgrade Riverview Towers and Centennial Terrace, Watson \$218,254; and Ausable Fire Station to be Re-bid.

Upcoming work includes: Fort Drum MATOC, Ogdensburg Wal Mart, Ausable Forks-New Fire Station, Canton CSD Capital Outlay, Saranac CSD Phase 2, Theresa Primary School HVAC Upgrades, Chazy Orchard Migrant Housing, Postwood Park Bathhouse Renovation-Potsdam and Hermon-Dekalb CSD Kitchen Renovation.

School projects that are in various stages of development: Belleville Henderson- \$4.4 million South Jefferson, General Brown, Lowville Academy & CSD \$44 million, Clifton Fine, Colton Pierrepont and Ogdensburg City Schools.

I have meetings scheduled to discuss upcoming projects including work through the Bridge and Port Authority in Ogdensburg and the Hydrogen Plant proposed in Massena.

At the trustees meeting yesterday, we reviewed the status of the funds. One thing I learned was that the use of Teladoc can really help keep our healthcare costs down. They showed an average savings of \$500 per visit for our plan. About 10% of visits were done with Teladoc. The higher that number goes the more money we save.

I am continuing preparations for negotiating the Credit Union and Inside Construction agreements.



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
