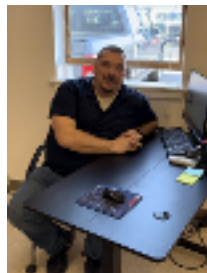

The EJATC of Watertown has hired David Gregory as a full time instructor for our Watertown location. David has been a member of Local 910 for 10 years. Currently we have 58 Journeymen on Book I, 0 on Book II, 15 Apprentices, 9 Residential-CE/CW's and 1 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Village of Sackets Harbor Pumpstation - NYTRIC and Edwards Knox CSD Collins-Hammond \$308,000.

From Executive Board Report: COP Thousand Islands CSD-SC Spencer \$105,450, Champlain Fire Station-Rozell \$406,000.

Upcoming work includes: Inflight Interceptor Communication Systems Fort Drum, COP Beaver River CSD, ST Regis Mohawk Tribe New Wastewater Treatment Plant, Beaver Falls WWTF, SUNY Potsdam Timmerman Lab, Long Sault Dam Gate Hoist Automation, Watertown Airport Fuel Farm Upgrades, COP South Jeff CSD and Massena Green Energy Hydrogen Plant Building Construction.

We are starting to get a little busier with some apprentices getting back out to work and there have been a few Journeyman calls. With the nice weather, I am hoping some of the solar jobs will start back up and some of the new ones will start early. Michels Power is supposed to be adding manpower in the next few weeks in Massena and Croghan.

I have received phone calls from a couple of large contractors that are bidding the Rich Road Solar Project in Canton. This is a 300MW project that is supposed to start in the Spring of 2025 and be completed in 2026.

We had a building trades meeting in Gouverneur last week. The St. Regis Mohawk Tribe was unwilling to use a PLA for the Wastewater Treatment Plant or other projects coming up. We will continue to look for ways to secure more work in that area.

I had a meeting with our lobbyist to review the Governor's Budget and Legislative Agenda for this year. She anticipates the budget passing in a timely manner because there are not a lot of policy items in the budget. We discussed proposed legislation and how it would affect the IBEW.

Mark Capone will be at our March meeting to give an overview of our funds and make his recommendations for the \$3.00 increase that we will appropriate at the meeting.
