Business Managers Report

Currently we have 52 Journeymen on Book I, 5 on Book II, 12 Apprentices, 40 CE/CW's and 4 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Lake Placid CSD Auditorium AV Upgrade-S&L (U) \$179,00; Capital UPDATE Project Parishville-Hopkinton CSD-Watson (U) \$564,000; Brasher Falls CSD Capital Project-Watson (U) \$900,475; and OGS Boiler Replacement Valcour Comfort Station Peru-S&L (U) \$67,185.

Upcoming work includes: Alexandria Bay DOT Boiler Replacement, Peru WPCP Disinfection Upgrades, South Lewis CSD Capital Improvements, SUNY Canton Bathroom Renovation Cooper Service Complex, Potsdam Public Library Renovation, Ft. Drum Airfield Lighting Upgrade, Franklin County Public Safety Building Renovations, Horse Island Development, Malone DOT Boiler Replacement, Lyon Mountain WWTP Upgrades, Ogdensburg CSD Capital Improvements, Ogdensburg New Transportation Facility, Ogdensburg Marina Improvements, Pine Camp Apartments.

Cyber Security Quotes- one has been received; still waiting for the other two. First quote is for about \$800 per year for \$1 million of coverage.

Pine Camp Project- working with contractors (section 3 requirements, manpower available).

Meeting with NYPA about the Alcoa Powerhouse Demo and Solar Projects they are working on permitting for. The Ironworkers are being bolder about trying to get into the solar racking through PLA's.

Update on the Union Strong App- we are in the design phase of the app, next step is importing data.
