Report at April 2023 Regular Meeting

Currently we have 50 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 5 Apprentices available, 0 Residential-CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Potsdam CSD Rebid-S&L \$990,000; Plattsburgh International Airport Renovations-Triangle \$233,868; Renovations to 100 Patterson St. Building Ogdensburg-GC Sparx (NU) will self-perform electrical; Malone CSD Phase 2-Perras Companies \$859,700; SUNY Plattsburgh Memorial Hall- WJ Murray no price; Altona Prison Boiler and Controls-Weydman \$160,000; Plattsburgh Airport Passenger Boarding Bridge-S&L 65,000; Town of Ticonderoga Generator- Triangle Electric \$71,145; Clinton Correctional Facility Design and Construction- O'Connell \$8.7M' and North Country Community College Lab Renovations-Rozell East no price.

From Executive Board Report:

Massena Airport Improvements-Baseline-\$784,000 (NU); Sackets Harbor Market Square Park- Lawman 1.2 M; and North Country Community College Lab Renovation- Rozell East (U) No price.

Upcoming work includes: Carthage CSD Capital Project Phase 4, Crown Point Wastewater Treatment Plant, St. Lawrence University Appleton Arena Phase 2, and Town Of Orleans WWTF Upgrades.

O'Connell Electric and Mass Electric have both been adding manpower to their solar projects. We have some unfilled calls. Both jobs are supposed to be done in the middle of May. Michaels Power has started work at some of the sub station projects they have. They gave me start dates for each location. These dates are when site work and excavation will start so it will be a few weeks before they need electricians on site.

IBEW Local 910 has turned in all supporting documentation to Kiewit for the jurisdictional dispute we have with the laborers involving the installation of underground electrical conduit.

I attended the IBEW Government affairs conference in Washington DC. We learned about legislation that effects the IBEW and what stage it is in. The Government Affairs Department unveiled a new app and website ibewgov.org that is a good resource for politics. There is a tab under issues and campaigns labeled Scorecard that you can go to. Once you enter your zip code, it will show who your representatives are and how they voted on bills that are important to the IBEW. I had a chance to speak with Kirsten Gillibrand and Adam Schiff in person. I talked to staffers working for Claudia Tenney, Chuck Schumer and Elise Stefanik.
