Business Managers Report

Currently we have 53 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 16 Apprentices, 40 CE/CW's and 3 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: SUNY Potsdam Maxcy Hall Renovations-TEL inc., Hand in Hand Early Childhood Classroom Addition-Tri County Electric (NU), Replace Boiler DOT Region 7 Jefferson County-Empire Northeast (NU) \$62,575, Peru WPCP and Disinfection Upgrades-Triangle \$1,342,800 and South Lewis CSD Capital Improvements-S&L \$2,189,000.

From Executive Board Report: Plattsburgh City Hall Repairs-Triangle \$146,000, Horse Island Development-Blackstone \$623,510, Replace Boiler DOT Malone- Weydman \$75,350, Lyon Mountain WWTP- Next Era (NU) \$229,600, Mt. Van Hovenberg Sliding Track Utilities-Weydman \$584,777, Mt. Van Hovenberg Sliding Track Buildings 1&3-Gross Electric \$100,000, Ogdensburg New Transportation Facility-Collins-Hammond \$1,422,200, City of Ogdensburg Marina Phase 2-Perras Companies and City of Watertown Lift Stations Generator-Blackstone \$171,000.

Upcoming work includes: Plattsburgh Waterfront Integration Project, Thrive Wellness and Recovery Watertown, Crown Point CSD Renovations, Malone Veterans Memorial Park, Shoe Dept Encore Ogdensburg, Ausable Valley CSD Capital Project Phase 1, Castorland Water Storage Tank Improvements, Hilltop Towers Generator Replacement Watertown, Gouverneur CS EV Bus Chargers, Jefferson Boces BTC Expansion, Town of Hounsfield Sewer District 1, Madrid-Waddington CSD Phase 2, Clinton CF Replace Chiller Units, Ogdensburg Bridge and Port Childcare Center, Town of Brownville Water System Improvements, Beekmantown CSD and Wellesley Island Park Entrance Reconstruction.

Air Products has cancelled the project in Massena, citing regulatory developments rendering existing hydroelectric power supply ineligible for the Clean Hydrogen Production Tax Credit and a slower than expected development of a hydrogen mobility market in the region. Our contact for the Massena job basically said the same thing that was reported in the news. We talked about calling our representatives and trying to help with the tax credit decisions, but he said Air Products is cutting ties with this project and is not interested in any support. They are in the process of securing the site and demobilization.

At last month's regular meeting we decided to split up the \$2.75 increase by adding \$1.50 in wages, \$.50 H&W, \$.50 Pension, and \$.25 Annuity.

We are still working on the Union Strong App. Currently we are adding information to it and testing its functionality before we launch it. We will be using the app to send reminders for dues, resigns, meetings etc. We are hoping to have it up and running in April.
