Currently we have 56 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 8 Apprentices available, 5 Residential-CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data technicians available for work.

From Executive Board Report: Watertown Fire Department Exhaust Capture System-Air Cleaning Systems (NU) \$169,989, DANC Rodman Maintenance Shop-Empire Northeast (NU), Wellesley Island State Park Dump Station - New Century \$36,736, Alexandria Bay Locker Room Renovations rebid Kahrs (NU), Salmon River CSD Phase 6- Dow (NU) \$327,000, and Tupper Lake Railroad Maintenance Shed-Weydman \$302,500.

Upcoming work includes: Upstate Correctional Facility Rec Pens, Town Of Clifton Water Treatment Upgrades, Fort Drum Panera Bread, Essex County Farm Worker Housing Site 2, and Plattsburgh and Mineville BOCES Capital Improvement.

Work continues to be slow at this time. Some of the bigger projects we were counting on have been experiencing delays.

I am in Harriman this week for the final session of New Business Manager Training. We are learning about record keeping, and preparation for DOL audits. Later in the week, we will be covering Fiduciary Duties and Budgeting.

We have some dates scheduled for negotiations with the Champlain Telephone Company. We have selected a negotiating committee, and we will be meeting in the next few weeks to prepare.

I finished compiling a list of solar developers with proposed projects in our area. I sent out introductory letters and shared contact information with our contractors.
