Business Managers Report

Currently we have 30 Journeymen on Book I, 8 on Book II, 0 Apprentices, 0 CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work. 28 Travelers and 6 Retirees working in our jurisdiction.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Clayton Municipal Marina Utility Upgrades-New Century, Tupper Lake Sunmount Fire Alarm Upgrades-Weydman, Tupper Lake Low Income Housing-Weydman, Michelin Warehouse Plattsburg-Weydman \$1.4 Million.

From the Executive board report: Chazy Rural School/Industrial Arts Project-Dow (NU) \$1,343,000, City of Watertown women's locker room and generator project- TEL Inc. \$260,950, and Watertown Municipal Arena Sound System NCC (NU)\$72,000.

Upcoming work includes: Harrisville CSD Capital Outlay, Essex County Agricultural & Youth Center, Watertown Airport Passenger Bridge, Ogdensburg Dollar Tree, Watertown Municipal Arena Sound System, OGS North Region EV Chargers, SUNY Canton Halford Hall HVAC Replacement, Massena School of Business, Massena High School Capital Outlay, Watertown and Fort Drum Booster Pump Replacement, Heuvelton CSD Capital Outlay, Minerva Central Schools Capital Project, Lowville Academy CS Capital Outlay Project, Clinton CF Renovations to Cells in Block C, and Watertown Airport Parking Lot Lighting.

Two of the large solar projects we have are starting to wind down. We are expecting layoffs this week. The Massena Hydrogen Plant will be adding manpower next week.

We finished shooting video for the marketing campaign in Clinton and Franklin Counties. Thank you to everyone who participated.

I attended the Commanding General Nauman's Fall Festival on Fort Drum on Saturday September 21st.
