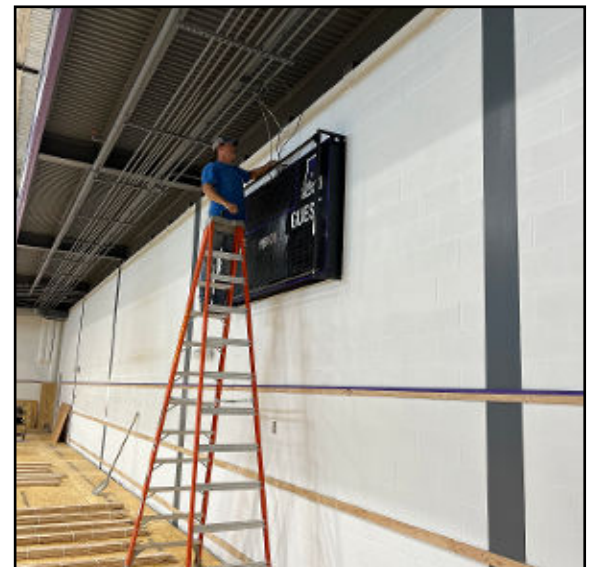

Currently we have 53 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 4 Apprentices available, 5 Residential-CE/CW's and 1 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Replace Elevators Dulles State Office Building-Watson \$203,000; Malone Housing Authority Riverside Haven-Dow (NU) \$340,000; Alexandria Bay Girls Locker Room Renovations- Dow (NU) \$14,665; Riverview Correctional Facility Replace Heat Exchangers-Watson \$280,600; Tupper Lake Rail Station-Weydman no price; and Mineville-Lot 11 Development-Next Era no price.

From Executive Board Report: St. Lawrence Appleton Arena-S&L, Adirondack Cf Building 1 & 20 Roof Replacement-Weydman \$88,000, Town of Chazy Sewer pump station upgrades-Weydman, Parishville-Hopkinton CSD COP-Zero Draft Commercial (NU), Replacement of windows and lights for Flower Memorial Library- Zero Draft Commercial (NU), SUNY Canton- CARC Replace VESDA Fire Alarm System-TEL Inc. \$57,097, and Eisenhower & Snell Lock Compressor Building Feeders- Collins-Hammond \$675,243.

Upcoming work includes: Hammond CSD Capital Outlay Project, Long Salt Dam Underground Feeders and Fiber, Ogdensburg Airport Pre Work, Salmon River CSD Capital Project, SUNY Canton Kennedy Hall Upgrades, and Louisville Water Treatment Upgrades.

Work continues to be slow at this time. Some of the bigger projects we were counting on have been experiencing delays.

I attended the Third District Progress Meeting in Philadelphia. The focus was on retention. We have done a good job of adding members to our Local Unions but we are still losing large numbers which has negated the new members brought in. At Local 910, we will continue to track our membership numbers and look at ways to improve.

We had a building trades meeting this week, and went over the schedule for the Massena Green Energy Hydrogen Project. We learned that Perras Companies will be doing the site work along with perimeter lighting. We went over the project schedule for this phase of the project. Site Clearing is supposed to start October 2,2023, and the first electricians are scheduled to be on site in April of 2024.

The Feasibility study came back for a PLA at the Watertown Airport. It showed cost savings but there still isn't much support from our legislators. I have been working on improving this situation. I would encourage our members to reach out to your County Legislator and let them know you support a PLA for the Watertown Airport Project.
