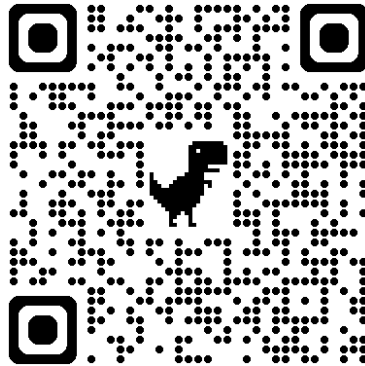

Business Managers Report

Currently we have 27 Journeymen on Book I, 1 on Book II, 0 Apprentice, 1 CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: South Platt Street Park Renewal Plattsburgh-Dow (NU) \$75,000, Melissa Penfield Park Renewal Plattsburgh-Next Era (NU) \$51,200, Clifton Fine CSD-Watson \$1,511,138, Bohlen Technical Center Expansion-Tel Inc. \$194,300, NYPA Alterations Former Alcoa Powerhouse-Weydman (no price), Town Of Leray Highway Garage-Empire Northeast (NU) \$120,750, Town of Pierrepont Highway Garage-Collins-Hammond \$275,000, Fort Covington Wastewater Disinfection Project-Perras \$367,990, CVPH Emergency Power Upgrades-WJ Murray, Chazy Rural School Improvements- Dow (NU) \$69,200.

From Executive Board Report: Ogdensburg Housing Emg. Light Replacement-Next Era (NU) \$57,000. Colton Water Treatment Plant-S&L.

Upcoming work includes: Marina Utility Upgrades, Village of Waddington Arena Storage Project, Village of Saranac Lake Municipal Building Energy Improvements, Mill and Main Street Affordable Housing Watertown, South Jeff CSD Bus Garage, Parishville-Hopkinton CSD COP.

Work continues to be busy: we have 30 travelers working in our jurisdiction, mostly on the solar sites. The manpower requirements have been challenging to meet. We have 109 members working for the 4 contractors doing most of the solar work.

I attended the Membership Development Conference in Chicago last week. Our membership continues to grow, we have over 800,000 A members. We reviewed referral policy and best practices for continuing to grow our locals. I also attended the 3rd District Progress Meeting where suicide awareness was a priority. The construction industry ranks second for most suicides. The IBEW is promoting a free hotline for anyone in need. It is the Suicide and Crisis Lifeline 988. Anyone in need of assistance can dial 988 and have a confidential conversation, you are not even required to give your name. There are coins, stickers and poker chips available to help promote the hotline. There was also a presentation about Electricians Without Borders and the work they are doing in Arizona. They are looking for volunteers and or donations. There was also discussion about the importance of the upcoming election.

There have been a few snags with the schedule at the Massena Hydrogen Project, but we still have 4 guys working there. They are behind schedule and are not expecting to add manpower until the end of October.
