Business Managers Report

Currently we have 28 Journeymen on Book I, 1 on Book II, 1 Apprentice, 1 CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

From Executive Board Report: Clifton-Fine CSD-Watson \$1,511,138, Watertown BOCES Expansion-Tel Inc. \$194,300, NYPA former Alcoa Powerhouse Alterations-Weydman (no price), Clinton County Exhaust Fume Capture-Air Cleaning Systems (NU) \$75,900 (self perform), Town Of Leray Highway Garage-Empire Northeast (NU)-\$120,750.

Upcoming work includes: Chazy Rural School Industrial Arts Building Capital Project, Town of Jay Parking Lot Lights, Clayton Municipal Marina Utility Upgrade, Pierrepont Town Highway Garage Addition, SUNY Canton Nevaldine ADA Entrance, Village of Waddington Arena Storage Area, Village of Saranac Lake Municipal Building Energy Improvements, Town of Colton WTP Improvements, Town of Fort Covington Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements, Mill and Main Street Affordable Housing Watertown, Belmont Courts Emergency Lighting and South Jeff Bus Garage.

Work continues to be busy; we have 4 out of town contractors doing solar projects and currently have 71 members working for them. We have added around 30 new members for these projects and the majority have worked out well. It has been a good opportunity for people that have applied for the apprenticeship program, but have not been accepted yet, to go out and work these jobs. I am hoping that some of the other solar projects that haven't started yet will continue to be delayed so people can go from one solar job to another.

The Hydrogen Plant has started to ramp up and there have been a few issues that we need to resolve through the PLA meetings. They have started to pour foundations for the buildings and plan to add manpower in October.
