Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 45 Journeyman on Book I, 3 on Book II, 2 Apprentices, 28CE/CW's and 3 Tele-data technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: SUNY Plattsburgh Hudson Annex Replace 3 Rooftop Fan Units-Weydman, Indian River CS Capital Project-Next Era (NU) \$774,000, Project Violet Warehouse-Weydman no price, Project Otis Warehouse- Matco no price, Canton BOCES Mechanical& Electrical Upgrades-Collins-Hammond \$102,000.

From Executive Board Report: Hopkinton Fire Station-Next Era (NU) \$192,250, Gouverneur CSD Phase 2-Collins-Hammond \$4.82 M, Warneck Pump Station FEMA Repairs-Scriba \$95,000, City of Ogdensburg Generator Replacement-S&L \$92,000.

Drum NEC communication Tower Light Replacement, Akwesasnee SRMT Expansion, Moriah Police Dept. Building Renovation, EV Charging Stations Lots 2,5,8,12,13, SUNY Canton, Solar Array Westport, Parishville -Hopkinton COP, 1223 Pickering Street Rehab Ogdensburg, Upstate Correctional Facility Cold Storage Building.

We had the Nuclear 101 meeting in Alexandria Bay. There was a good turnout, the room was full. There were several speakers from the industry that did a good job explaining these Small Modular Reactors. Scott Gray explained the next step for those interested in having a reactor in their town. It sounds like a long process, and we are in the beginning phase.

Lawman and Lundy are working on getting a developer to choose Watertown for a \$250 Million Dairy Processing Facility. Southern Dairy is looking at a 40-acre site on outer Massey Street.

Calls have been coming in pretty steady this month we expect calls for Michels Power Coffeen Substation.
