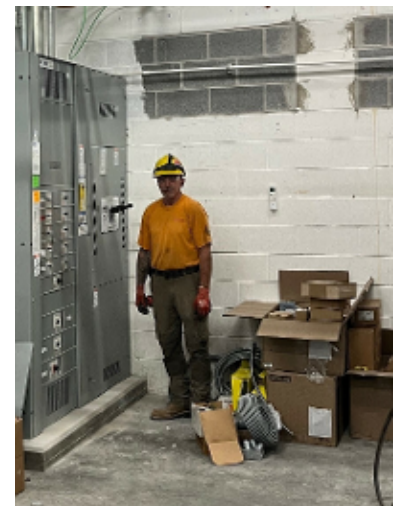

Business Managers Report

Currently we have 39 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 11 Apprentices, 3 Residential-CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data technicians available for work.

From Executive Board Report: ADK Regional Airport-Next Era (NU) \$934,500, Upstate Correctional Facility Circulation Pumps- Dow (NU) \$40,200, Clifton Fine CSD-Dow (NU) \$936,000, Dulles State Office Building Restroom Renovations-Dow (NU) \$445,319, Alexandria Highway Garage- Kahrs Construction (NU) \$84,000.

Upcoming work includes: Watertown International Airport, Martinsburg Water and Wastewater Improvements, Gouverneur Transfer Station Improvements, SUNY Potsdam Clock Tower Alterations, Rouses Point New Land Port Of Entry, Clifton Fine CSD Capital Improvements, Town Of Orleans Library Improvements, Ellisburg Free Library Renovations, Brookfield Power Watertown Industrial Center Renovation, Town of Alexandria Highway Garage Renovations, Wilna Housing Authority Parking Lot Lights, Ausable Forks WWTP Improvements, Henderson Water Quality Improvements, Watertown International Airport Weather Equipment, Salmon River CSD Install Solar. Norwood Boces Welding Labs, Colton Pierrepont CSD, Gouverneur CSD Middle School Renovations, Salmon River CSD Solar, Watertown Airport Fuel Farm, DANC Adams Sewer Improvements, Wilna Housing Authority Parking Lot Lights.

We had a Labor Management meeting where we discussed our advertising campaign and our plan to extend our reach into Clinton, Essex and Franklin counties. A representative from the DPAO talked to us about potential sponsorships and what the DPAO does.

I attended a meeting of the New York Association of Electrical Workers. There was discussion about some of the grants out there through NYSERDA and the challenges associated with them. There was also a political update.

We had another kickoff meeting for the Massena Green Energy Hydrogen Plant. The next phase is scheduled to start in June. JW Didado a contractor from Ohio has this phase of the project. They expect to have 3 or 4 JW's and 1 apprentice through summer. The next phase hasn't been awarded yet, but they are projecting a need for 10 JW's around October.

Evans Mills Speedway IBEW night May 18th was a successful event. We had around 30 people in attendance. I think everyone enjoyed it.
