Report at June Regular Meeting

Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 50 Journeymen on Book I, 4 on Book II, 7 Apprentices, 40 CE/CW's and 3 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Clarkson Inn Renovations-Link (NU), Potsdam CSD Capital Improvements-Collins-Hammond \$81,000, Hermon Library Renovations-Empire Northeast (NU), Gouverneur CSD Athletic Facility-Empire Northeast (NU) \$1,753,000 and SUNY Potsdam Wiser Botanical Gardens Dow (NU) GC Bid \$365,482.

Upcoming work includes: Alex Bay Water Tank, SUNY Plattsburgh Lounge Improvements Harrington Hall, NYS Rt 56 Water District, Constableville WWTF UV System, Indian River CSD Solar Upgrades, Ogdensburg CSD Capital Improvements Phase 1, River Hospital Renovations Alex Bay, SUNY Potsdam Camera Initiative, Turin Fire Department Lighting Retrofit, BOCES Canton Mechanical and Electrical Upgrades.

FROM THE EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING -

Jobs bid in the last two weeks: Include: Improvements to STP Disinfection Village of Dexter- S&L Electric \$83,772, Modifications of Street Lights Village of Norwood- Northline Utilities \$40,200, New Storage Tank System Improvement Alexandria Bay- Blackstone Electric \$122,104 and Construction of NYS 56 Water District Town of Potsdam- Khars Construction (NU) \$304,000.

Upcoming work includes: Improvements to Water System town of Champion, Capital Project HVAC upgrades Watertown City School HT Wiley.

The Federal funding for the Kraft Project has been officially pulled. It is unclear if Kraft will go forward with the project. The plan called for \$170 Million for Kraft-Heinz to decarbonize 10 production facilities with Kraft-Heinz spending an additional \$177 million of its own money.

We had a NYS Business Managers meeting last week. We are working on a Prefab agreement that covers New York State. Right now, prefab language is a little different in each CBA. There are a few Union Contractors in New York with prefab shops so we are starting to see jobs where items are prefabricated in one jurisdiction and brought into another. We want to make sure that the right rates are paid and hours are reported back to the Local that has the project.

There is currently a House Resolution that would Nullify OSHA and shift the responsibility to the employers and the States called NOSHA. We have obvious concerns with this and there is a "NOSHA Toolkit" available on the IBEW Government Affairs Website. It includes sample letters and additional resources to contact our elected officials concerning NOSHA.
