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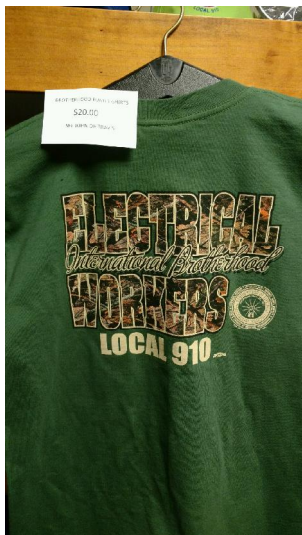

Business Manager *(Report at December Regular Meeting)*

Currently we have 47 Journeyman on Book I, 13 on Book II, 1 Apprentice, 2 Residential, CE, CW's and 0 Tele-data Technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last week include: All the projects in this report had Union Contractors as low bidder; Tupper Lake Central Schools had Northern Pioneer low at \$344,750; Adams Water Improvements went to Knapp for \$88,750; Heuvelton CSD had Watson low bidder at \$339,000; and Gouverneur WWTF went to Northern Pioneer for \$167,800.

Upcoming work includes: 3 Story Addition at the Samaritan Medical Center, Several Dollar Stores, Plattsburgh Airport-Building 2774 Renovation, Plattsburgh FedEx Distribution Facility is being rebid, Plattsburgh Price Chopper Renovation, Town Of Constable-Petroleum Containment Building, Carthage School, Thousand Islands Border Crossing, South Jeff School, SUNY Potsdam-Kellas Hall Renovation, Fort Drum NCO Academy, Fort Drum Infrastructure related to the Overpass on Route 26, expansion and restoration of Agri-Mark's Chateaugay facility, Norsk Titanium, expansion at the Kraft Plant in Lowville, a new development for a wind farm on Galloo Island, Jericho Rise Wind Farm, and the Copenhagen Wind Farm is out for bid with our work in 2017.

School projects that are in various stages of development: Madrid-Waddington \$3.2 million, Clifton-Fine \$3.6 million, Brasher Falls \$10 million, Peru \$2.8 million, and Thousand Islands School 6.9 Million.

Our work has continued to hold strong. We now have over 25 travelers working in our jurisdiction. There have been layoffs from the Jericho Rise Wind Farm as the tower wiring is complete; some of those JW's have gotten back out to work.

The Thousand Island Border Crossing project drawings are out;

- December 19th is the scheduled bid date (I expect the bid date to be delayed).
- Both phase 1 and 2 are bid at this time; phase 1 is funded and phase 2 is optional.
- The total budget is \$185-195 million.
- Proposed completion date for phase 2 is June 2022.
- There are over 1500 pages of drawings.
- Award will be in the spring 2017 and constructions starts in June.

This is a very big project if both phases are awarded. I will be working hard to track who the players are. There were 12 General Contractors at the pre-bid meeting, which was optional. Of those, I believe five (5) would be able to bid it. Because this is a Federal Government job it will be bid to a GC and the Electrical Contractor will be a sub. Both S&L Electric and O'Connell Electric attended the walk thru.

The decision on the preferred site for the East Coast Missile Defense site has now been pushed off till after January 1st (2017). Rumors are that it is down to 2 sites with Fort Drum being one of them.
