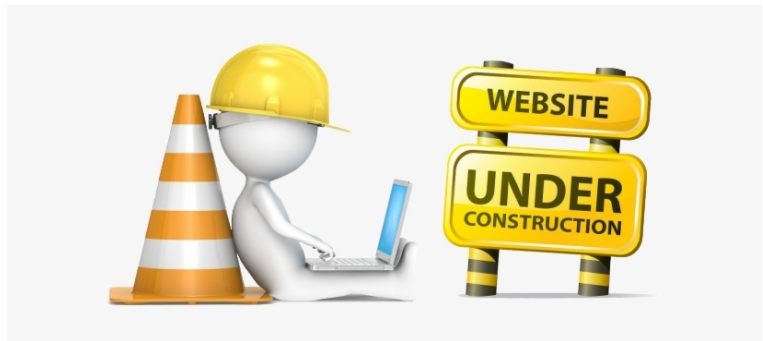

Report at January Regular Meeting

Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 67 Journeyman on Book I, 0 on Book II, 4 Apprentices, 3 CE/CW's and 1 Tele-data technician available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Plattsburgh Airport Security-S&L \$1.6 Mil, SUNY Plattsburgh-Weydman.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include (from Executive Meeting): Waddington Electric Vehicle Charging Stations-Empire Northeast (NU) \$68,950, Wellesley Island Water Corp. System Upgrades-Northern Pioneer \$113,800, Sunmount DDSO Pool Ventilation-Next Era (NU) \$145,500, Improvements to Water District 4 Town of Watertown-Blackstone \$44,870, Watertown Airport Grant Restaurant-Northern Pioneer, St. Lawrence Addiction treatment Center Removal of Central Steam Loop-Empire Northeast (NU) \$87,950.

Upcoming work includes: Carthage Elementary COP, St. Lawrence Addiction Treatment Center-Steam Loop Removal, SUNY Plattsburgh Myers Studio Upgrades, Heuvelton CSD Capital Project, New Town Hall Altona, City of Watertown Hydro Upgrades, Apartment Renovations Lowville, Plattsburgh State Softball Field, Rouses Point Water Treatment Plant.

Upcoming work includes (from Executive Meeting): Plattsburgh State Softball Field, Clinton County Landfill Phase 5 Cell 2D Liner Expansion, Kehoe Bathroom Renovation SUNY Plattsburgh, Water Treatment Plant Improvements Rouses Point, Wheeler Sack Army Airfield Lighting Upgrade, ADK Fish Hatchery Brook Trout Expansion-Pole Barn.

The Watertown City Courthouse Project was bid in October but rejected by the last City Council. It has been recently approved by the new City Council. Watson is the lowest bidder at \$477,000. The project is now scheduled to start in February or March.

Local 41 and 237 are still very busy and good places to sign.

I have been working on our proposals for contract negotiations with Northern Credit Union. We plan to start in February.

I have been appointed to the Development Authority of The North Country (DANC). It has been quite a process, but I received my appointment from Governor Hochul and was sworn in last week.
