Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 45 Journeyman on Book I, 0 on Book II, 0 Apprentices, 7 CE/CW's and 1 Tele-data technicians available for work.

Upcoming work includes (From Executive Meeting): Ray Brook Water Supply System Improvements Phase 2, Beaver River CSD, SUNY Canton Cooling Tower, Improvements to Depauville WWTS, Jefferson County Social Security Entrance Addition & Renovation.

It has been a quick start to this construction season with several calls coming in for work all over our jurisdiction. With all the bid activity I am sure we will stay busy through the summer. We are doing a critical shortage effective April 1st so the retirees can return to work without stopping their Local Pension. Hopefully, this will help us fill job calls. Of all the bid results I reported, only one went to a non-union contractor. It is extremely important to man the work in our Local, so our contractors can continue competitively bidding this work.
