Report at July Regular Meeting

Business Manager's Report:

Currently we have 42 Journeyman on Book I, 0 on Book II, 1 Apprentices, 12 CE/CW's and 0 Tele-data technicians available for work.

Jobs bid in the last two weeks include: Jefferson BOCES Adult Learning Center-NYTRIC, Clayton Municipal Marina-New Century \$291,880, Sunmount Tupper Lake-Weydman \$4.7 Million.

Upcoming work includes: O'Reilly Auto Parts Store Malone, EV Charging Stations Essex County Government Center, Upgrade Electric Panel and UPS Southworth Library SUNY Canton, Carthage CS Capital Project, Town of Moira Sewer Collection System Upgrades, Replace Chiller at Civic Center Village of Malone, St. Lawrence Psychiatric Center BLDG 69 & 105 Decentralization Project.

I have been informed that the funding for the Wheeler Sack Airfield Lighting project has been pulled. I think this project will be revisited in the future because it is still important to the base because it affects military readiness.

Fort Drum is one of nine bases being considered to host an SMR (Small Scale Nuclear Reactor) through the JANUS program. Of the nine Fort Drum was one of the military bases selected for a site visit recently so it's a good sign that they are still on the list.

Governor Kathy Hochul signed an Executive Order to create the nation's first moratorium on new hyperscale data centers, she says the executive order will establish the strongest standards for data center development and create a blueprint to support localities. The Governor is temporarily pausing State environmental permits for up to one year in order to build the regulatory framework that protects ratepayers, the environment, the energy grid and communities across the state. I am looking to meet with NYDIG to see how this affects their proposed data center in Massena.
